### Scholarship Consideration

Unfortunately, we will not be able to offer you a scholarship to attend the MIT Global Entrepreneurship Bootcamp. Past scholarship recipients include, a researcher who developed a cancer diagnostic lab on a chip, a co-founder who sought to reduce preventable deaths by creating the country's first blood supply chain information system, an engineer who wanted to bring clean water to every home in developing countries.
